For example, if original certification scope covers yogurt (as per product specification say, PS 1:202x), can there be extension of certification scope so as to cover new products like: i) Cheese (as per PS 2:202x) ii) Butter (as per PS 3:202x) etc.
<b>7. In addition, as a Note, the text has no normative impact and thus cannot restrict or permit anything.
