4.6. TF Conformity Assessment Schemes (CAS) (Jauhari / Geneiatakis) The TC held a discussion and vote on the status of the Mandatory Document on the Evaluation of Conformity Assessment Schemes (CAS). This was necessary because two days before, on May 10, the task force on this document held a meeting to discuss the results of the vote that took place in January which was negative on the document. The May 10 meeting did not result on agreement on a way forward. Some in the TF were looking for a way to keep the document alive but with no consensus in the TF to continue with the document, the decision was pushed back to the Technical Committee. Many members were not clear on the rules after a no vote. Some thought the project was finished. The Chair indicated that, per IAF PR 2, 3.14, a document with a no vote goes back to the TC Chair and he chose to send it back to the TF. DAKKS is still waiting for a response to its complaint regarding the January vote. Others also voiced concerns with procedural issues. APAC member do not agree with document. A number of other ABs are also opposed. Some thought that the addition of 5.2 was the issue but concerns go way beyond 5.2. The TC needs to decide if to continue. Even though the document was originally voted down, the voice ballot result is to continue working on the CAS document: 36 yes and 17 no.	IAF-TC-04.6-21-1

5.2.	<p><b>Proposed General Assembly (GA) Resolutions</b></p> <p>The 4 agenda items below, submitted by CABAC, were considered together. The issue is that one particular AB does not abide by TC decisions and CABAC proposed to make those TC decisions IAF resolutions. A very spirited debate took place. There were unfortunate accusations of misrepresenting the facts.</p> <p>Members had different opinions regarding if TC decisions are mandatory or not. What is the impact of a TC decision? Can IAF force members to comply? What about other TC decisions? Did discussions with the AB took place? Was a complaint filed by the CB against the AB? Is this a procedural issue? Concerns were expressed about TC discussion becoming more political than technical. There was general agreement that something is wrong but the CABAC proposed solution is not the best approach.</p> <p>A vote took place but the process was unclear. The TC did not request Abstentions and some AB members on the call did not vote at all. The ballot ended in a 24-24 draw. It is unclear what are the next steps. The TIC Council voted against the ballot because it was persuaded by the arguments presented during the TC meeting.</p> <p>The TC chair indicated that using the complaint process seemed to be the best approach. He also indicated that he would take up the issue with the IAF Executive Committee.</p>
