CNBCh UW building is located at a district of Warsaw named “Ochota” at the UW Campus. Main entrance to the Campus is from Banacha street. The location is close to the city centre, to the main railway station as well as to the “Chopin” airport.

You can easily get to the meeting venue from these hotels. It is a foot distance about 20-30 min or about 10 min by bus. **Bus stop “Banacha-szpital”**.

There are also some comfortable hotels, at various pricess in the city center where you can get by bus, tram or metro.

3. HOW TO GET TO US

The venue is easily accessible by the following transport hubs:

Warsaw Central railway station (Centralna):

by bus 175, 521; by tram 7, 9, 25

Warsaw West railway station and coach station (Zachodnia):

by bus 187, 182, 523

Warsaw Chopin Airport:

by bus 175, 188

If you look for the information about the buses, trams, metro or trains, you can easily check it with jakdojade.pl website. It is also possible to download it to your phone for free.

Bus, trams and metro tickets you can buy at the **Ticket Machine**. Ticket machines are located in most vehicles, near bus stops and metro stations.
